Conditions of participation in the CGMA University Program at the Vilniaus Kolegija (VIKO), academic year 2025/2026

- 1. Joint program implemented by the AICPA & CIMA and the Vilniaus Kolegija (VIKO), hereinafter: "CGMA University Program").
- 2. CGMA University Program is intended for students majoring in Accounting, Bachelor's degree in Business Management.
- 3. The CGMA Program at VIKO covers the following levels of the CGMA Professional Qualification and offers the students an opportunity to obtain a respective CGMA designation:
 - 3.1. Certificate level: Certificate in Business Accounting (CGMA Cert BA);
- 4. CGMA Program students complete the educational program mapped by the University against the CGMA syllabus, which is approved by AICPA & CIMA.
- 5. The CGMA University Program at VIKO requires completion of the following set of subjects (taught in Lithuanian or in English):
 - 5.1. Certificate level: Certificate in Business Accounting (CGMA Cert BA) in the first degree studies

- 6. In order to complete the CGMA University Program and obtain a CGMA certificate, students are obliged to:
 - 6.1. read CGMA Program's policy and accept its provisions;
 - 6.2. enrol for the CGMA Program and register with ACIPA & CIMA between the 3rd and 5th semester of the first-cycle studies;
 - 6.3. complete an educational program, mapped by the University against the CGMA syllabus, pursuant to point 5.
 - 6.4. pass a standardized external CIMA's CGMA exam before the end of the calendar year in which they graduate.
 - 6.5. pay any fees related to their participation in the CGMA Program and external exam.
- 7. AICPA & CIMA and the University reserve the right to remove the student from a CGMA Program roster if the candidate fails to take CIMA's CGMA exam(s) and/or fails to pay applicable fees and/or violates any AICPA & CIMA's terms and conditions.

8.	Students who meet all requirements indicated above and complete the CGMA University Program will be sent a certificate after 12 weeks from receiving the 'pass' result of their final exam at each level.
