- 1. Joint program implemented by the AICPA & CIMA and Wroclaw University of Economics and Business, hereinafter: the "CGMA University Program")
- 2. The CGMA University Program is intended for students majoring in:

- 6. In order to complete the CGMA University Program and obtain a CGMA certificate/diploma, students are obliged to:
  - 6.1. read CGMA Program's policy and accept its provisions;
  - 6.2. enrol for the CGMA Program and register with ACIPA & CIMA;
    - 6.2.1. between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester of the first-cycle studies for the Certificate in Business Accounting level;
  - 6.3. Complete an educational program, mapped by the University against the CGMA syllabus, pursuant to point 5.
  - 6.4. Pass a standardized external CIMA's CGMA exam before the end of the calendar year in which they graduate.
  - 6.5. Pay any fees related to their participation in the CGMA Program and external exam.
- 7. AICPA & CIMA and the University reserve the right to remove the student from a CGMA Program roster if the candidate fails to take CIMA's CGMA exam(s) and/or fails to pay applicable fees and/or violates any AICPA & CIMA's terms and conditions.
- 8. Students who meet all requirements indicated above and complete the CGMA University Program will be sent a certificate after 12 weeks from receiving the 'pass' result of their final exam at each level.
- Master's students at WUEB can continue their studies with CIMA and benefit form the CGMA Finance Leadership Programme (FLP) – a fully digital e-learning and exam platform focused on the key competencies needed to advance your career in finance.
